Queen's Park aim to raise awareness and understanding in both the club and wider community of the impact of the war on the club and the 226 members and players who enlisted for military service, 33 of whom died. Their story has remained virtually unknown until now. The centenary of many of the battles of the Great War will occur between now and 2018.
